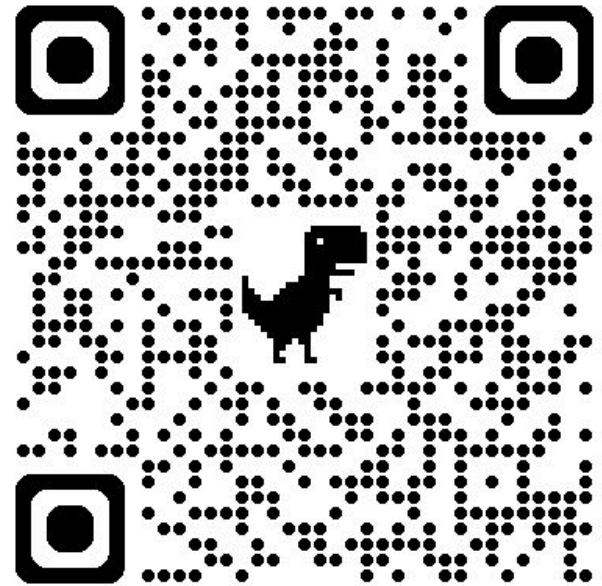

# On Track Handout

## 9th Grade

- Earn at least 6 credits by the end of the year

**Do this by:** passing at least 12 semester classes

*Emphasis on the cores (Math, Sci, Soc, & English)*

## 10th Grade

- Earn at least 12 credits by the end of year

**Do this by:** passing another 12 semester classes

## 11th Grade

- Earn at least 18.5 credits by the end of the year

**Do this by:** Passing another 13 semester classes

## 12th Grade

- Earn at least 24.5 credits by the end of the year

**Do this by:** passing another 12 semester classes

- Demonstrate Math & English Mastery

**Do this by:** Earning a set score on SAT, ASVAB, Accuplacer, or other exam
