

Hybrid and Online Attendance Policy

General Attendance Requirements:

- attendance has a two-prong measure online work and on-campus attendance
- attendance in a hybrid or online school is based on the overall number of assignments, not course-specific assignments
- attendance will be calculated on a weekly time schedule, not a daily.
- all students are expected to work on their assigned virtual days. attendance will be calculated according to the minimal amount of work completed.
- all students must sign in and out when on campus. even virtual support times
- see off-campus policy regarding leaving campus during the day
- parents must report all absences to the attendance secretary (719-494-8924) within 48 hours of the absence

Hybrid Attendance Requirements: HYBRID STUDENTS ONLY

- Attendance for hybrid students is calculated with on-campus time and minimal numbers of assignments completed with virtual work
- Online attendance equivalency calculations are illustrated in the table below
- On-Campus attendance will be calculated through time station. All hybrid students must sign in using our TIME STATION system (all students have an ID and 4-digit pin). This will be used for attendance.
- Attendance is mandatory

<u>Full Virtual Attendance Requirements:</u> VIRTUAL STUDENTS ONLY

- Families must complete a full virtual contract
- Attendance calculations are purely based on minimal submissions of work not physical presence

Excused versus Unexcused Absences

You have 48 hours to report an absence or it will automatically be unexcused

Excused Absences may include:

- Illness, injury, legal proceedings
- Arranged absences pre-approved by the administration for family activities, appointments, etc.
- Absences to attend school-sponsored activities

<u>Unexcused absences may include:</u>

- Oversleeping or forgot
- Skiing, Vacation (not pre-approved)
- Studying
- Car, traffic, train, city bus trouble
- No notification

<u>Procedures for addressing absences:</u>

- Parents must report all absences to the attendance secretary (719-494-8924) within 48 hours of the absence
- Requests for pre-approval must be submitted in writing at least 3 days prior to the absence
- Absences and truancy will be reported to the district Truancy Officer

Habitually Truant Students

A Student is considered in violation of the Attendance Policy if he/she:

- is not attending on-campus requirements
- is not submitting the required minimum number of assignments (please reference the chart above)

Truancy

- Students who are determined to be habitually truant are:
- Failing coursework
- Being unexcused for more than four days per month
- Having more than 10 unexcused absences in a school year.

Habitually truant students will be reported to the D49 Truancy Officer.

Truancy may affect your continued enrollment.



Hybrid Student Examples Only

Student A:

- Completes zero online assignments during a week
- Does not come on campus for classes

Student A will earn 4 unexcused absences for the week for not attending on-campus work and not meeting minimum submissions for the week

Student B:

- Completes zero online assignments during the week
- Does come on campus for classes

Student B will earn 2 unexcused absences for the week for not meeting minimum assignment submissions

Student C:

- Completes required number of assignments during the week (virtual courses)
- Does not come on campus for classes

Student C will earn 2 unexcused absences for the week for not attending on-campus work

Student D:

- Completes required number of assignments during the week (virtual courses)
- The student has flu during on-campus days and parent calls the student in

Student D will earn o unexcused absences for the week since parent excused absences



Full Virtual Student Examples Only

Student A:

• Completes zero online assignments during a week

Student A will earn 5 unexcused absences for the week for not meeting minimum submissions for the week

Student B:

• Student B completes 7 assignments for the week

Student B will earn 3 unexcused absences for the week for not meeting minimum submissions for full attendance for the week

Student C:

• Student C completes 14 assignments for the week

Student C will earn 1 unexcused absence for the week for not meeting the minimum submissions for full attendance for the week

Student D:

- Student D comes down with Influenza A and parents excuse the absences
- Student D may be required to provide a doctor's note

Student D will have met the minimum requirements for full attendance for the week. Assignments will not be excused and will need to be made up.
