## PPEC Honor Society Eligibility Policy

According to the <u>National Junior Honor Society (NJHS) bylaws</u>, NJHS is open to rising 7th-9th grade students. NJHS Eligibility is determined by:

- 1. The student must have a GPA of 3.50 to be eligible. Students must not have had any discipline referrals during the school year.
- 2. All students who are eligible will receive an NJHS application with a deadline for the application to be completed and returned.
- 3. All applications received BY THE DEADLINE will be reviewed by the NJHS committee and students will be notified whether or not they were accepted into NJHS. Accepted students will receive an invitation to the NJHS induction ceremony.

According to the <u>National Honor Society (NHS) bylaws</u>, NHS is open to rising 10th-12th grade students. NHS eligibility is determined by:

- 1. The student must have a GPA of 3.75 or higher and have no discipline referrals during the school year.
- 2. All eligible students will receive an NHS application with a deadline for the application to be completed and returned.
- 3. All applications received BY THE DEADLINE will be reviewed by the NHS committee and students will be notified whether or not they were accepted into NHS. Accepted students will receive an invitation to the NHS induction ceremony.
