- 8. Principal Report (*Kris Levi*) 9:05-9:25
  - a. Title I Update
    - i. How was money spent this year?
      - 1. Staffing
        - a. Lead Interventionists, Reading Interventionist Paraprofessionals, Hourly Math Tutor, Hour Reading Tutor
      - 2. Resources
        - a. Intervention Curriculum, Training, Substitutes for team planning, and more
    - ii. Tentative - Changes for next year
      - 1. Staffing
        - a. School Social Worker will be substituted for Lead Interventionist since ESSER funding is ending. Odyssey operated an intervention model with a Lead Interventionist for several years prior to the last two years.
        - b. The Title I Family Liaison position is now required to be paid from the Title I budget.
        - c. The additional Lunchroom Monitor position is being eliminated.
        - d. No other staffing changes.
      - 2. Resources
        - a. Seeing Stars, Emergenetics, and other cuts are necessary to maintain future needs and other current levels.
      - 3. Odyssey is one of the very few schools that, due to an increased percentage of Free and Reduced Lunch numbers, has a small increase in our Title I funding.
