6. District Accountability Committee (DAAC) report – (*Jasmin*) 12:25-12:30
  - a. On Tuesday, the DAAC meeting primarily discussed the MLO that will be on the ballot. MLO stands for Mill-Levy Override. The measure passed 3-2. The BOE weighed family economics vs. teacher economics.

- b. D11 and D20 have resources and money available that create a highly competitive teacher market. We have teachers leave our district for other districts.
    - c. 7%, 7 years, 7 mills. The “7-7-7” plan is correlated with student achievement. The district must hit performance benchmarks in order the the salary increase to be funded by the MLO.
    - d. Pay schedules are being revised in February. Many people on the DAAC were concerned about the complexity of D49 pay schedules and the potential for a lack of transparency in the process.

    - i. Odyssey CMAS scores have been released. While they are public, OES has been collecting this school year’s data before looking at last year’s CMAS results. A formal examination will be coming soon.
    - ii. 3rd Grade: ELA - 44.0->29.9; Math 34.0->31.2 (Apples to Oranges)
    - iii. 4th Grade: ELA - 32.8->45.7; Math 25.4->25.5 (ELA above District)
    - iv. 5th Grade: ELA 33.8->50.9; Math 21.5->29.1 (ELA above District)
  - b. School Performance Framework (SPF)
    - i. Odyssey achieved a “Performance” rating. This is the preferred category according to the State’s expectation.
