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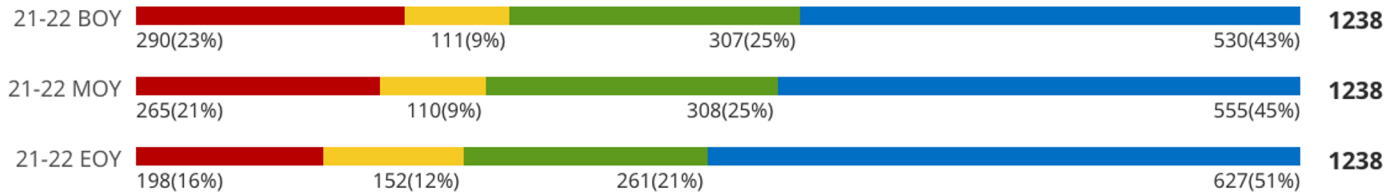

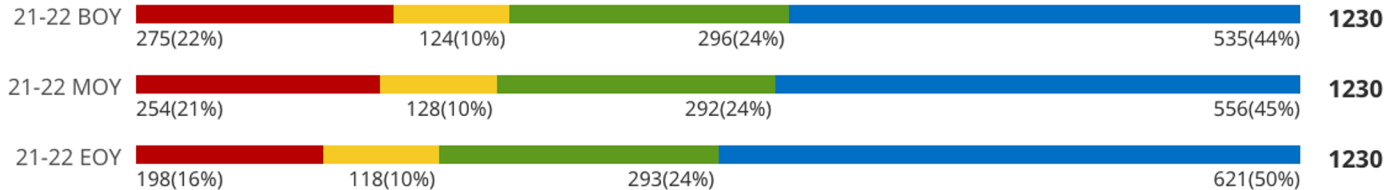

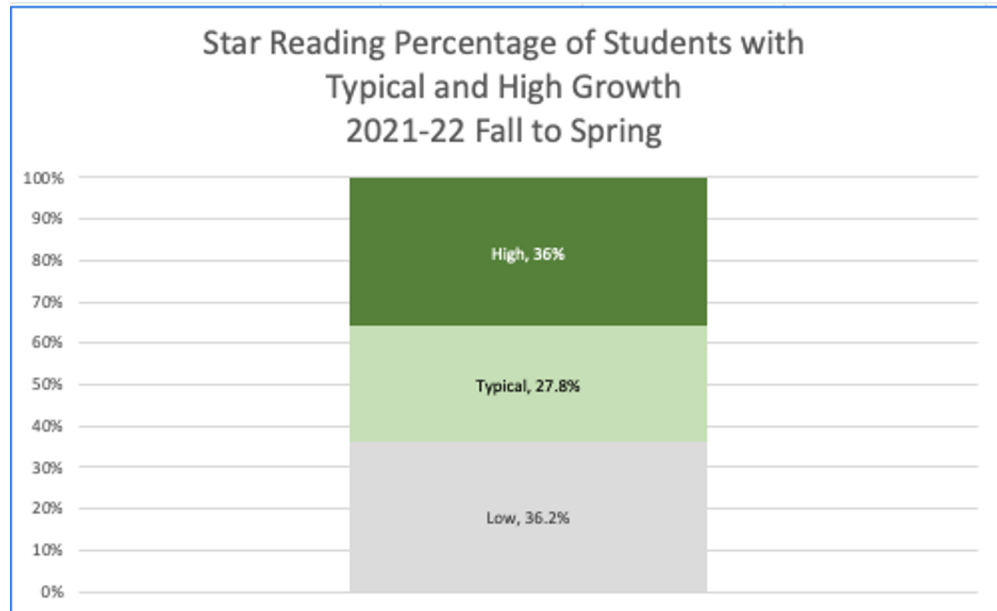


- Which grade levels met the EOY goal identified on the Amplify Growth Tool?

# STAR 360: Typical or High Growth



- ★ 64% of students in grades 2-10 achieved Typical or High Growth on Star Reading at EOY



**There are 3 bands for student growth:**

- High Growth = 65% - 99%
- Typical Growth = 35% - 64%
- Low Growth = < 35%
