

We Love D49 Teachers A Proposal to Improve Teacher Pay



This November, voters will have the chance to make a meaningful investment in local education

Hiring teachers has become a cutthroat competition. Districts with greater resources are specifically pursuing high-performing and experienced teachers. D11 and D20 have at least three times more local funding than D49.

Because business properties yield much more tax revenue, our competition to the west has much more local revenue to invest in teacher salaries.

The 777 Proposal



A 7 mill commitment asks the typical D49 homeowner to invest less than \$20 a month —far less than our teachers dedicate year after year.



Guaranteed 7% teacher raises

100% of funds generated will go to teachers



Conditional sunset after 7 years

If D49 academic performance improves 40%, as measured by the Colorado Department of Education, then the commitment continues with no new taxes.
