Principal Corner

Hello Odyssey Families,

On behalf of all of us here at Odyssey Elementary, Happy Thanksgiving! We are thankful and grateful to be a partner in the social and emotional growth of your child as they move toward adulthood.

As part of this partnership, we are working with your children to develop reading, writing, math, and critical thinking skills. We are also working on positive character traits, too. In this aspect, we know that children benefit when supports are wraparound and include the school, the home, and a student's sense of personal responsibility.

As our kids come back after Thanksgiving, we appreciate the role you play. Here are some great things that you may find helpful to review with your child to help our whole Odyssey Team have a great December and finish 2023 strong:

- **It's important to get plenty of rest.** Many of our younger elementary students go to bed as early as 7:30! While every child is different, please reiterate the habit of going to bed on time to provide plenty of rest for brains to get ready for the next day.
- **Routines are important.** Our school day is full of learning at some times, with breaks and recess at others. Understanding that we shift activities throughout the day is important for students. If your child wants to practice routines to prepare to return, it may be beneficial.
- **Words can hurt.** Students can have arguments, and we're ready to guide them when tensions occasionally arise. If one student is repeatedly targeting another, however, that is not okay. They should tell a trusted adult, and we'll take necessary steps.
- **It is never acceptable to hit or kick at school.** We encourage students to use words or find adults if they are having a struggle. Teachers are here to help and to teach. Students are here to learn, work cooperatively, and have positive interactions with peers and adults. Students who hit or kick other students or our staff take away from this learning. We are always willing to restore, but our students also need to understand that negative actions have consequences.

We care deeply for our students. This spark of the heart is what has led us to this calling. We want to continue to partner with our Odyssey families in a way that is honest, genuine, and with the end in mind. As always, feel free to reach out should you have any questions.

PowerSchool is the District’s web-based tool providing real-time insights on student grades, schedules, performance, and attendance.

Before you can access your student information, you must create a new parent account (*existing IC accounts will not work in PowerSchool*).

You need to have at least one student Access ID and Password to create an account. If you have multiple students in our district, you should have received an email for each of those students with an Access ID and Password to link each of your students as you create the account.

If you did not receive an email containing the Access ID and Access Password(case sensitive), please contact your student's school to obtain this information.
