You also can generally catch teachers outside at dismissal time, if you have a quick question. Of course you can also email or call the teacher as well.

Our general school policy states that all visitors must sign in at the office and wear a sticker badge, and that all classroom visits must be pre-arranged as mentioned above. If a staff member asks you to report to the office to sign in and get a sticker badge, please know that they aren't trying to offend or upset anyone. SAFETY is our number one priority, always! STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT is a top priority as well, and limiting classroom interruptions ensures that instructional time is utilized to its fullest potential.
