Mike Pickering provided an update on facilities. He has been meeting with the project manager - Melissa Andrews and the architect to continue to move the Allies project forward. • Vision Update

Vision Committee meets every Monday. They have already met this year and it was a very productive meeting. There is almost 1 representative from each grade level. The committee members are very committed to goals that were set last January. There were 20 goals identified to be shared throughout the coming months. Communication is one of the biggest goals, based on feedback received. They are trying to improve communication overall with weekly emails and a quarterly newsletter.

Another focus is customer service, making sure parents feel valued. All goals are focused on the whole child and character education. Affirmations, and adding value. The goal is to roll out slow., starting with lessons that are coming from the book "The 7 Habits of Highly Effective People" by Stephen R. Covey. Nicole Shipley, Odyssey's counselor will go into classrooms to introduce the lessons to the children and then the trait will be reinforced at monthly assemblies. The goal is to start with some exposure this year and then hopefully start a formal training in year 2. Sarah is working to get teachers credit for the book study that is happening. Then grants for the full training down the road so the school can maybe become a "Lighthouse School" using the "Leader in Me".
