  - a. Cafeteria, Art Room, Staff Lounge, and Workroom are complete.
  - b. Next Phase – Classrooms and the core of the building will be completed through Fall Break, Spring Break, and Summer.
- 5. Restroom Updates – Student flooring and partitions are in rough shape. We are going to go with an epoxy flooring that does not rust and does not allow anything behind it. The north bathroom will need additional work since the fixtures were not installed correctly. All restrooms will be updated by the beginning of the next school year.
- 6. Safe Entry – D49 elementary school floor plans do not funnel visitors to the office. Our safe entry will be installed over the summer.
