



Fees:

This year we will be collecting a student fee and a personalized learning fee. During our back-to-school bash, we will collect these fees. There will be an option to pay your fees online, but you will need to ensure you have access to your parent portal. If you need assistance with your parent portal, please reach out to our front office.

- **\$25 student fee** - covers the first student ID and lanyard, grade level educational materials (science labs, etc.), guest speakers, and learning enrichment opportunities.
- **\$35 - PZ Personalized Learning Fee** - The funds will be used to contribute toward (not cover in full) the cost of personalized learning resources and tools, along with digital devices and device maintenance, consumable books, professional development, and other components required for effective personalized learning. Math and ELA will be prioritized in the use of these funds, but other content areas may also benefit.
- There will be an additional **(OPTIONAL) tech insurance for \$30**. This will cover the expense of a repair that is caused by **any misuse of the device**. We highly encourage you to take advantage of this insurance. Cost to replace a chromebook can be up to and exceed \$350.

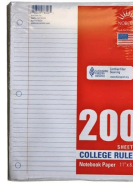
