The string orchestra program in the Sand Creek Zone is a huge success! Parents are totally committed to the program and the students (and their teacher) are loving it!

Students in the 5th grade have the opportunity to learn to play violin, viola, cello or bass. I am very excited to be able to help your child begin this new adventure of playing a stringed instrument. We will have a great time, gain many new skills, and perform wonderful music together this year. Enrollment is open through September 7, 2015

This is a beginning program and the student does not need any previous skills in music. Learning an instrument requires diligence; therefore he/she must make a **one-year commitment** to play in the orchestra. Your student will need to rent (\$20 - \$60 per month) or purchase (\$400 - \$800) an instrument and purchase the "Essential Elements 2000 for Strings" method book (around \$10) for use during the year.
