- Brings parent perspective

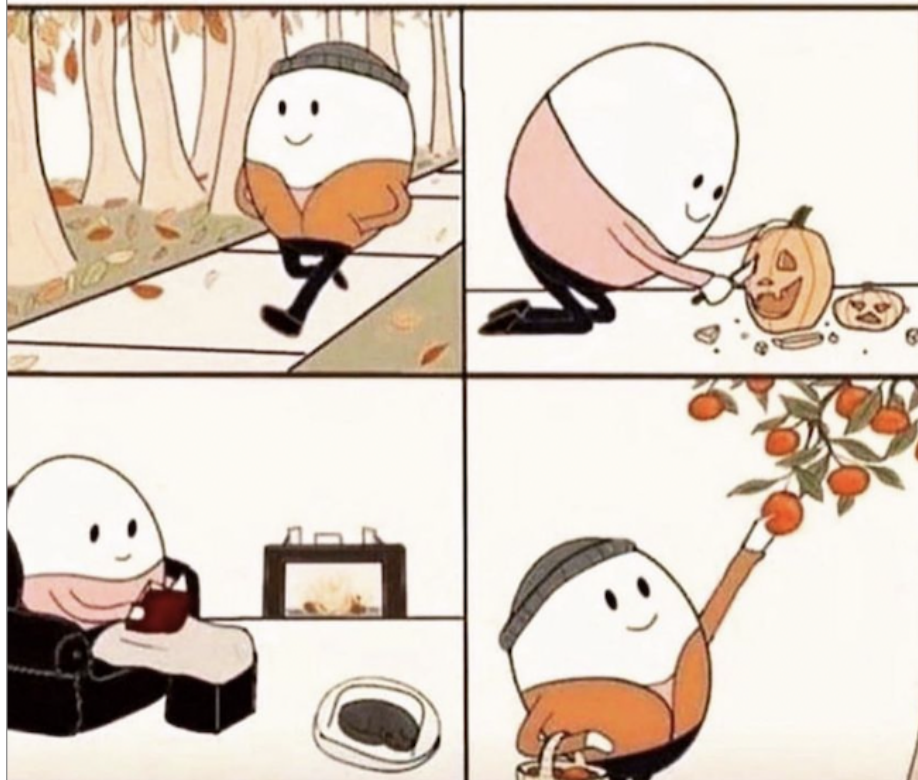
Teacher Representatives: Erin Bedell, Kara Sandborn
