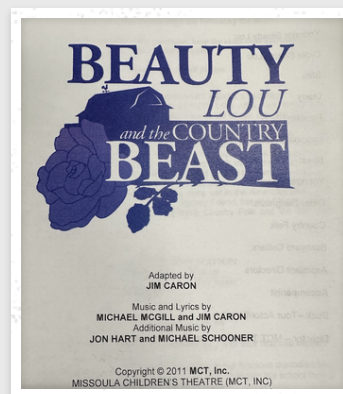
D4.9K! OUR MASCOT WON THE RACE!
