### **Important Information**

#### **Student Fees:**

#### CMAS Data released:

We are excited to share that our CMAS scores have improved. We are now a performance school! This is a credit to our amazing IVES educators and our hardworking students. Go IVES!

Students in grades 4th and 5th will be coming home on Thursday, August 31st with an envelope containing their CMAS scores from last year. Score reports can shed light on a child's academic strengths, highlighting the subjects and skills in which they excel. They also can pinpoint areas that require additional attention and support. Information on the score report can help foster meaningful conversations with parents about strategies you can use at home to support your child.

#### Access WIDA Data released:

If your child is in the CLDE program here at IVES and took the WIDA test last year, their scores will be coming home in an envelope on Thursday, August 31st. Please review your student's scores as they highlight areas that they excel in and can pinpoint areas that require additional attention.

#### **3rd Graders testing for Cogat:**

Our 3rd grade students will be taking a test called the Cogat test. This test is a universal assessment that all 3rd grades students will take towards the end of the month. A paper will come home with your students to explain this assessment.

#### **Bathroom Behavior:**

We are off and running but need your help and partnership to discuss proper bathroom protocol. Our wonderful building maintenance team is cleaning up wadded up toilette paper being thrown on walls, bodily fluids all over the floor, replacing missing plastic parts and more. We are implementing the Golden Plunger as a positive reinforcement for the cleanest bathroom to earn an extra recess and are working to do hourly bathroom checks as well. Please discuss this with your child(ren) at home as we will have consequences for students that are intentionally vandalizing our bathrooms. Thank you for your support with this serious matter.
